Using the DNR Asbestos Online Notification System for Flood Damaged Structures


As stated in the U.S. EPA and Iowa DNR Asbestos No Action Assurance and Asbestos Authorization the 10 working day waiting period is being waived for projects in counties included in a disaster declaration made by the President of the United States. For most types of notifications the database is coded to require a 10 working day waiting period in order to submit the notification online. Please follow these database instructions for submitting an abatement, renovation, or demolition notification for flood damaged structures. This procedure will allow responsible parties to submit notifications online and immediately begin work.

Asbestos Abatements or Renovations

Select the Operation Type "Emergency Renovation". By selecting this notification type the 10 day waiting period does not apply to the project start date. In Step 5 of the notification there is a field for the "Description of the emergency or sudden event". In this field state it is a flood damaged building included in a disaster declaration. Complete the submittal process.


IOWA DNR - ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION SYSTEM



Demolitions

For standard demolitions select the Operation Type "Demolition". In order to submit this notification online, the responsible party will have to enter a 10 working day start date. The end date can also be the same as your start date. At the bottom of the page in Step 1 of the notification, there is a comment field labeled "Asbestos Location". In this comment field state the date the demolition is actually taking place per DNR's Asbestos Authorization. Complete the submittal process.
