



SPECIAL 2011 ANTLERLESS DEER HUNT

Pine Lake State Park

PERMITTED WEAPON IS: ARCHERY ONLY

HUNTING DATES: October 1, 2011 to January 10, 2012

Information (Please read before completing application):

1. License applications will be accepted from September 1. Those received after September 29 will be individually qualified by appointment.
2. 50 antlerless deer licenses will be issued for the Pine Lake special archery hunt. The first 25 qualified hunters will have an option of acquiring a second tag. Licenses will continue to be issued until the total of quota is reached.
3. Only one application per individual per envelope will be accepted (Exception: 1 adult + 1 minor child 12 years or older. A child must have completed a Hunter Education Course to participate in this special hunt.)
4. Successful applicants will be notified by telephone and are required to attend one of two safety/orientation meetings and pass an archery proficiency test to qualify for the hunt. Once the hunter has attended the required safety meeting and passed the archery proficiency test, they will be allowed to purchase the antlerless tag from the Hardin County Recorder's Office. The hunter will not be able to purchase the tag before attending a of the safety meetings.
