



**Springbrook State Park**  
**2011 FIREARMS ANTLERLESS DEER HUNT**  
**HUNTING DATES: December 10 and 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

**License Obtaining Information:**

1. Licenses are available mid-August and can be purchased through December 9 or until quota is reached.
2. Licenses can be purchased **only** through license agents listed in most current Iowa Hunting and Trapping Regulations (including the park office).
3. Park staff is able to accept completed applications and sell licenses to applicants who include appropriate payment.
4. Applications will be accepted from **August 15 – December 1**. Applications received after December 1st will be rejected.
5. You must include checks made payable to "Iowa DNR" for \$28.50 (if first license) or \$13.00 (for second or additional antlerless licenses) along with your application in order for licenses to be sold. Sold licenses are non-refundable.
6. Residents 16 years or older are required to have a valid hunting license, habitat fee, and deer license on their person.
7. Residents born after Jan. 1, 1972 must satisfactorily complete a hunter education course in order to obtain a hunting license.
8. Residents under 16 years old do need a deer license but do not need a hunting license if under direct adult supervision and the adult is properly licensed. One properly licensed adult must accompany each unlicensed hunter under 16 years old.

**Deer Management Hunt Information:**

- ✓ The hunt is only offered to Iowa residents.
- ✓ Licenses purchased for deer management areas are only valid for those specific areas.
- ✓ The Springbrook management hunt is restricted to antlerless-only deer.
- ✓ There is a quota of 75 licenses sold on a first-come, first-served basis.
- ✓ Hunters may purchase multiple licenses before and during the weekend hunt, if available.
- ✓ Only persons with the Springbrook deer license will be permitted in the State Park during the above dates.
- ✓ **All hunters who successfully purchase Springbrook management deer licenses are required to attend a one-hour safety and orientation meeting at the Park Office prior to participating. The orientation meeting will be December 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 AM.**
- ✓ Hunting licenses, habitat fees, deer licenses, tags, and a photo identification are required to be verified by park staff in order to participate.
