SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The goal of the Becoming an Outdoors-Woman (BOW) scholarship program is to broaden participation in the 2017 weekend workshop to women 18 years old and older who would be **unable to attend without financial assistance**. BOW encourages anyone to apply for a scholarship. However, preference will be given to first-time attendees and those promoting diversity in outdoors education across the state through their community affiliations, culture, region, and/or profession.

- 1. Scholarships cover \$130, which is half of the full registration fee. **Scholarships will not be awarded for applications scored below 30 points** (see Scoring Rubric on page 2).
- 2. Checks or money orders shall be made out to: IHEIA-BOW and mailed in with applications.
- 3. Scholarship recipients will be expected to write an article about your BOW experience, which may be published in DNR newsletters and in BOW promotional materials.
- 4. Applications must be received by August 31, 2017 mailed or emailed to:
