The focus of the update will be the 12-acre Foothills Park area of the preserve. Foothills Park is being considered for the location of the Loess Hills Archeological Interpretive Center. 5	<b>Lamson Woods State Preserve</b> – Two problems with the boundary of the preserve have been recently (September 2011) identified: 1) a portion of a tract (containing a mowed lawn, parking lot, bridge, and wooded drainageway) traditionally perceived to be a city park adjacent to the preserve has been determined to be within the preserve boundary and 2) a wooded area along Mint Boulevard traditionally perceived to be within the preserve has been determined to be outside. As one of two alternatives, the City of Fairfield is considering the placement of a dog park in the “city park” area next to Lamson Woods Preserve. Part of the proposed dog park, including its access, is within the parcel now realized to be inside the preserve. In January 2011, believing the site to be completely outside of the state preserve, the Preserves Board voiced no objection to the proposed dog park. However, in light of the corrected boundary, a decision is now needed.	Decision (John Pearson)
