3	<b>Heendah Hills management plan</b> – A final draft of the management plan for the proposed preserve is presented. Approval of the plan will complete the final step needed to write the dedication statement.	Decision – John Pearson
4	<b>Loess Hills Archaeological Interpretive Center</b> – As previously requested by the Preserves Board, a business plan for development of an archaeological interpretive center at the Glenwood Archaeological State Preserve has been written by the LHAIC Board of Directors. 6	<b>Decorah Ice Cave State Preserve trails</b> – An anonymous caller complained of unauthorized bicycle trails having been constructed in this preserve. Investigation by Kirk Larsen confirmed that two trails constructed in recent years by Decorah Human Powered Trails in cooperation with Decorah Parks and Recreation Department cross the north side of the preserve. A field trip to the site was conducted by Kirk Larsen and others on July 2; details will be presented at the meeting. Options for future of the trails need to be discussed.
