

Draft Fee Schedule

Senate File 488 established a limited fee program for specific activities. Fees will be set consistent with 567—Chapter 30 (new). The DNR is seeking comments on the draft rules posted on our [website](#) and on this draft fee schedule. The amounts listed, excluding the existing Title V emissions fee, are estimates. The final amounts will depend on which fees may be established.
