The 2014 Midwest Wildfire Training Academy (MWTA) is offered in conjunction with the University of Missouri Fire and Rescue Training Institute's Annual Summer Fire School and is sponsored in cooperation with the Big Rivers Forest Fire Management Compact (BRFFMC) and the United States Forest Service.

The BRFFMC is a partnership between the Illinois, Indiana and Iowa Departments of Natural Resources, the Missouri Department of Conservation and the USDA Forest Service's Northeastern Area State and Private Forestry. A USDA Forest Service National Fire Plan Grant for BRFFMC's MWTA will minimize the cost for students to attend the National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) courses being offered.

All courses will be taught to NWCG standards. Students should plan on attending each course in its entirety, and be prepared to take written exams. MWTA faculty meet the NWCG instructor prerequisites as outlined in NWCG Wildland and Prescribed Fire Qualifications System Guide (310-1). MWTA courses are open to all students that meet the qualifications requirements as outlined in the course description.
