

Course Content and Presenters

This full day of presentations will be offered on two consecutive days, and is designed to fulfill continuing education requirements for UST Professionals (compliance inspectors, installers, installation inspectors, removers, testers and liners), and UST professional development. This is also a chance for us to meet to discuss issues that affect your business. We are as much interested in hearing from you as we are in providing professional development.

Manufacturers' Agents

This year's Refresher will focus on sump containment and spill buckets. With the federal UST revisions published and ready for states to apply them, we have asked our manufacturers' agents to talk to us about the testing of single and double wall spill buckets, sump containment and also flexible and rigid entry boots for flat and round surfaces and angled entries.

Our agents will also talk about some common installation errors they see with their secondary containment systems and spill buckets.

Agents for this year include Bennett Schwartz with **OPW**, Gary Saltz with **Franklin Fueling**, Micah Nelson with **Bravo** and Jeff Hempel with **Walsh Long & Co.**

We look forward to hearing from our agents about their new containment systems, including single and double wall spill buckets, replacement spill buckets, piping, sumps and entry fittings.

Ivan Hankins and Mike Harrington, **Department of Agriculture/Weights and Measures** will join us to give update on new fuels.

Brian Pottebaum, **PMMIC/Rounds & Associates**, will discuss 2015 Inspection results.

Dawn Carlson and Jeff Hove, **Petroleum Marketers and Convenience Stores of Iowa (PMCI)** will speak to us about current trends in the petroleum retail industry, what we can anticipate and how it will affect UST professionals and owner/operators. Certainly the sunset of the UST Fund Board in 2016 will be a major topic.

The **DNR** will provide a preview of the new UST rules: what we can expect, when they might be implemented and how they will affect UST professionals and owner/operators. Other topics include new fuels update, grant programs for renewable fuels, corrosion in STP sumps and the results of the 2015 leak survey.


