The Derelict Building Grant Program works with communities of 5,000 or fewer people who need assistance with addressing abandoned commercial or public buildings all while diverting construction and demolition materials from the landfill.

2012 SUCCESS

CITY OF ONAWA

The City of Onawa abated asbestos and deconstructed an old grocery store achieving a **94% landfill diversion** rate for the total project. They achieved this rate by taking advantage of reuse markets for items like scrap metal, metal I-beams, and concrete. The city plans to market this site for a future commercial enterprise. By diverting the building materials from the landfill, the city **saved approximately \$22,709 in landfill fees.**
