

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) is proposing to issue a Title V Operating Permit to Global Ethanol LLC - Lakota. This facility is located at 1660 428th Street, Lakota, IA 50451. IDNR is currently reviewing a permit application submitted by Global Ethanol LLC - Lakota to operate their existing denatured ethanol plant.

Global Ethanol LLC - Lakota is required to obtain a Title V Operating Permit pursuant to 567 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 22.101. This facility has the potential to emit the following air pollutants annually:

PM-10 (particulate matter ten microns or less in diameter): 95.20 tons  
Particulate Matter: 108.23 tons  
Sulfur Dioxide: 55.20 tons  
Nitrogen Oxides: 161.90 tons  
Volatile Organic Compounds: 140.06 tons  
Carbon Monoxide: 110.51 tons  
Lead: 0.00 tons  
Hazardous Air Pollutants: 11.73 tons

Based on the information provided in the Title V Operating Permit application, the IDNR has made an initial determination that the facility meets all the applicable criteria for the issuance of an operating permit specified in 567 IAC 22.107.

A complete record of the permit review, including the permit application and the proposed permit, is available for public inspection Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., at the IDNR address shown above.

The public comment period for the proposed permit will run from October 26, 2009 through November 24, 2009. The beginning date of this public comment period also serves as the beginning of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) 45-day review period, provided the EPA does not seek a separate review period. During this time, anyone may submit written comments on the permit. Mail signed comments to Ling Li at the IDNR address shown above.

Written requests for a public hearing concerning the permit may also be submitted during the comment period. Any hearing request must state the person's interest in the subject matter, and the nature of the issues proposed to be raised at the hearing. IDNR will hold a public hearing upon finding, on the basis of requests, a significant degree of relevant public interest in a draft permit. Mail hearing requests to Ling Li at the IDNR address shown above.

IDNR will keep a record of the issues raised during the public participation process, and will prepare written responses to all comments received. The comments and responses will be compiled into a responsiveness summary document. After the close of the public comment period, IDNR will make a final decision on the permit application. The responsiveness summary and the final permit will be available to the public upon request.
