**Outreach:**

During the week ending May 1: Thirteen private campgrounds and One public campground were visited and informational packets were handed out. There was also a visit to a municipality and information was distributed there also.

**Regulatory:**

During the week ending May 1: State and Federal officials from Iowa and Wisconsin met at an Allamakee County, Iowa sawmill to witness the processing of Ash logs from Minnesota, Iowa, and Wisconsin. The officials also discussed the process of operating under a compliance agreement with the sawmill owner. The owner was also given the EAB Regulatory website to look over compliance agreements and the regulations dealing with Ash or Ash products.
