POSITIVE – One or more of the following symptoms:



D-shaped exit holes



Serpentine galleries

SUSPECT – Three or more of the following symptoms:

NEGATIVE – Two or less of the following symptoms:



Suckering



Bark Splits



Canopy Dieback



Woodpecker Damage

- 1.) Declining Ash
- 2.) Nurseries, Sawmills and Firewood Dealers
- 3.) Recently landscaped residential and commercial areas.
- 4.) Campgrounds, recreational areas and rest areas.
- 5.) Waterways, fencerows, and roadsides
- 6.) Major transportation arteries
- 7.) Rural residences
- 8.) Forests and woodlots
