Other Training

The Iowa DNR Fire Program also offers other non-NWCG fire training. We offer a series of 8 hour trainings that can be brought to your location for delivery. We require one month advance notice for scheduling these classes. The classes we offer are the following.

8 hr Introduction to Wildland Firefighting

Course is designed for those who have a limited amount of time to commit to the full NWCG S-130/S-190/L-180/I-100. Learn the basic techniques of fighting Iowa wildfires.

8 hr Engine Operator Course

Learn the basics of how to run engines in a wildland/urban interface area. Topics include pumps, driving, and tactics.

8 hr Prescribed (RX) Fire Course

Learn the basics of how, who, what, when and where about prescribed burning. Designed as an introduction to the process of burning. **This course will not make you a burn boss**, but it will give you a better understanding about the mechanics of a burn.
