**Timber sale area outlined in red is approximately 64.1 acres in size. The stand is comprised of mixed oak and hickory. Shelterwood harvesting will be implemented in order to increase natural regeneration. This will ensure a stand with a major oak component for wildlife and future generations to enjoy. There will be approximately 12-18 trees harvested per acre in order to reach our management objectives.**
