Your social security number will serve as your principal identification number to determine your eligibility for licenses. It will be provided to law enforcement agencies and the Iowa Child Support Collection Unit to establish, modify, and enforce child support obligations. It **WILL NOT** appear on your license.

Additional Nonresident Iowa Landowner Affidavit Information

Nonresident landowners who have not purchased nonresident Any-Deer/Antlerless-Only combination licenses may purchase an optional Antlerless-Only license available for either of the two regular gun seasons or the disabled hunter season only. Following submittal and successful DNR review of the Nonresident Iowa Landowner Affidavit, nonresident landowners may purchase an optional Antlerless-Only license beginning at 6 A.M. CDT on July 25, 2009. Optional Landowner Antlerless-Only license will be valid only on the farm unit of the landowner. For the purposes of obtaining this license, all land owned in Iowa by the applicant will be considered one farm unit.

Hints on obtaining County # and Parcel Identification Number (PIN)

For County#

Use the table on the left side of these instructions to obtain the 2-digit County Number for your qualifying tract of land.

For District#

You must provide a District Number if you own land in one of the following counties: Crawford, Keokuk, Tama, or Union. District Numbers are often listed on property tax statements. If you cannot locate or have questions regarding your District Number, please contact the County Assessor, Recorder, or Treasurer for the county in which you own land.

For Parcel Identification Number (PIN)

Each parcel of land in Iowa has an identification number that is used for property tax purposes. Parcel Identification Numbers are often listed as "Parcel" or "Parcel ID" on property tax statements. If you cannot locate or have questions regarding your PIN, please contact the County Assessor, Recorder, or Treasurer for the county in which you own land.

Nonresident Land Owner Iowa Code Language:

Section 483A.8, subsection 5 of the Code of Iowa: A nonresident owning land in this state may apply for one of the six thousand nonresident deer licenses and the provisions of subsection 3 shall apply. However, if a nonresident owning land in this state is unsuccessful obtaining one of the nonresident antlered or any sex deer hunting licenses, the landowner shall be given preference for one of the antlerless deer only nonresident deer licenses available pursuant to subsection 3. A nonresident owning land in this state shall pay the fee for a nonresident antlerless-only deer license and the license shall be valid to hunt on the nonresident's land only. If one or more parcels of land have multiple nonresident owners, only one of the nonresident owners is eligible for a nonresident antlerless-only deer license. If a nonresident jointly owns land in this state with a resident, the nonresident shall not be given preference for a nonresident antlerless-only deer license. The department may require proof of land ownership from a nonresident landowner applying for a nonresident antlerless-only deer license.
