The Iowa Department of Natural Resources is required to collect social security numbers from all persons obtaining a hunting, fishing or other recreational license under section 252J.8 of the Code of Iowa and 42 U.S. Code 666(a)(13).

QUALIFICATIONS:

Upon payment of \$7.00, the Department of Natural Resources will issue a lifetime combination hunting and fishing license to a resident of Iowa who served in the armed forces of the United States on active federal service.

Therefore, any and all licenses issued as a result will also be invalid and may be subject to penalties for making a false entry in a public record under Iowa Code 714.8(4), and for hunting, fishing, or trapping without a valid license under Iowa Code 483A.

- Copy of DD214
- Copy of a letter provided by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs stating you are entitled to a service connected disability rating. *(Not necessary if you are claiming eligibility due to Prisoner-of-War status.)*
- Photocopy of Hunter Safety Certificate *(Must include if born **after** January 1, 1972 and if requesting the Hunting/Fishing license)*
- \$7.00** License Fee *(Make checks payable to: Iowa DNR)*
- Duplicates of a previously issued license may be purchased from any license agent for \$4.50.**

NOTE: This license **does not** include any additional fish and wildlife fees. You must still purchase the appropriate fish and wildlife fees **each** year.
