Pine Lake State Park

Special Archery hunt

Pine Lake: October 1 2009-January 10th, 2010

- 50 antlerless – only licenses, up to 25 total hunters.
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- A lottery system will be used to select hunters if there are more than 25 participants at the orientation meeting.
- Archers must attend the orientation safety meeting.
- Hunting is for antlerless only deer. An antlerless deer is defined as a deer without a visible antler or with no antler longer than 7 inches &/or a forked antler.
- Shooting hours are ½ hour before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset.
- Transportation tag shall be affixed within 15 minutes of time deer is killed or deer is moved in any manner, whichever occurs first.
- Use of tree stands is recommended but not required. Attempts should be made to make shots at a downward angle.
- For safety use of a haul line to raise bow/quiver into tree stand is required.
- Hunters may not place nails or spikes in trees on public areas. Use of Wadsworth climbing blocks is recommended. State law prohibits cutting branches and trees.
- Stands shall be removed from the area within 2 weeks of the end of the season unless other arrangements are made with Park Manager. Hunters do not have to take down their stands each day. Recommended that stands be secured with a chain and padlock to discourage theft. At least one stand was reported stolen last year.
- Stands and hunting should be 25 yards from public use areas such as campgrounds and picnic areas. Stands should be placed 25 yards off trails to minimize contact with the non-hunting public.
- Use of safety harness in tree stands is highly recommended.
- Ground stands may be made with materials dead and on the ground. Dismantle ground stand at end of season.
- Must use broad heads when hunting.

- Do not gut deer on trails or in parking areas.
- Park in parking areas. Do not block roadways, except to pick up carcass of deer that has been dragged to a roadside.
- Place your large brown manila envelope on dash of your vehicle with your name facing up so that we know who is hunting. Let family members know when and where you will be hunting. Bring a cell phone if you have one to call in your deer to DNR for harvest records.
- Remember exactly where you shoot your deer. Park personnel may require you to show where your deer was shot.
- Hunters will have responsibility of dragging out their own deer. Do not drive off roadways to pick up deer. Park personnel, if available, may be able to assist and are authorized to drive state equipment off roadways.
- Archery hunters may wear camouflage & it is recommended.
- All deer must be reported to the Park Ranger in some manner before the deer is removed from the park.
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- Hunters may call the Park Ranger at 641-751-7400, and leave a message if necessary.
- Licenses will have to be marked should a Conservation Officer check your deer while it is being transported.
- **This year all deer harvested must be reported! Call 1-800-7771-4692 or go to, www.iowadnr.com to report your tag number.**

SPECIAL 2009 ANTLERLESS DEER HUNT

Information (Please read before completing application):

1. License applications will be accepted from August 1 through September 15, 2009. Those received after September 15 will be rejected.
2. 50 antlerless deer licenses will be issued for the Pine Lake special archery hunt. The first 25 qualified hunters will have an option of acquiring a second tag. Licenses will continue to be issued until the a total of quota is reached.
3. Only one application per individual per envelope will be accepted (Exception: 1 adult + 1 minor child 12 years or older. A child must have completed a Hunter Education Course to participate in this special hunt.)
4. Applicants must attend one of two safety/orientation meetings and pass an archery proficiency test to qualify for the hunt. Once the hunter has attended the required safety meeting and passed the archery proficiency test, they will be allowed to purchase the antlerless tag from the Hardin County Recorder's Office. The hunter will not be able to purchase the tag before attending a of the safety meetings.
5. **Successful applicants will be notified by telephone; and are required** to attend a one-hour safety and orientation meeting which will include an archery proficiency test. Applicants will be notified of the meeting dates when drawn.
