



SPRINGBROOK STATE PARK

SPECIAL 2009 ANTLERLESS-ONLY DEER HUNT

Springbrook will be hosting two antlerless deer hunts for 2009. An archery hunt will be held on Nov. 2-Dec. 20. The firearms hunt will be held on Dec. 12 & 13.

Please read the following before completing the application.

Archery Season:

- Applications will be accepted at the park office from November 1 -15, 2009.
- A quota of thirty (30) licenses will be issued only to Iowa residents on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Successful applicants will be notified by phone and be required to purchase a license and meet with a park officer prior to the hunt during business hours.
- The park will remain open to the public during the archery hunt.

Firearms Season:

- Applications will be accepted at the park office from November 16 – 30, 2008.
- A quota of seventy-five (75) licenses will be issued only to Iowa residents on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Successful applicants will be notified by phone and be required to attend a safety orientation meeting at the park office on Saturday, December 12 at 6:00 a.m.
- The park will be closed to the public from Friday evening through Sunday evening during the firearms hunt. Only licensed hunters will be permitted to enter.

General:

- Only one application per individual per envelope will be accepted (*Exception: 1 Adult + 1 Minor child 12 years or older must be in same envelope. Licensed hunters born after Jan. 1, 1972 must have successfully completed a Hunter Education Course prior to submitting the application to participate in this special hunt*).
- License fee: \$27.00 (first license) or \$12.00 (second or more licenses) must be paid along with the submission of the application (check payable to "Iowa DNR").
- Unsuccessful applicants will have their checks voided and returned.
- The harvest is restricted to antlerless-only deer as defined by Iowa Code (deer with no forked antler).
- Hunters must have in their possession, at all times, a valid Iowa hunting license and the special Springbrook antlerless only deer license. The vehicle must display the index card with the hunter's name in clear site whenever in the park.
- A photo identification (and Hunter Education Certificate, if required) will be required for admittance to the meeting.
- All hunting regulations will be enforced.
