FY 2010 Intended Use Plans for DWSRF and CWSRF

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources and the Iowa Finance Authority will hold a public meeting on May 11, 2009 beginning at 10:00 a.m. at the DNR Water Supply office at 401 SW 7th Street, Suite M, Des Moines, IA 50309. Comments are invited on the Drinking Water and Clean Water State Revolving Fund Intended Use Plans for the State of Iowa Fiscal Year 2010.

The Intended Use Plans (IUPs) present the State's administration of revolving loan funds for drinking water systems, wastewater treatment works construction, stormwater management, and non-point source projects.

It is anticipated that the Environmental Protection Commission will act on the IUPs at its June 16, 2009 meeting.

Written comments will be accepted through May 18, 2009. Oral comments may be presented at the meeting.
