Sample Budget Explanation

Budget explanations are required. The format below is an example of a budget explanation for the Sample Budget shown on the page above. Your budget explanation should detail specific expenditures in each category, and indicate the amount contributed from each source.

SAMPLE ONLY:

Personnel:

Jay Smith, environmental educator at Simon Nature Center, will work approximately 687 hours on this project at \$30/hr., including fringe benefits (FB), for a total of \$20,606. Simon Nature Center requests \$7,506 from REAP CEP. The Nature Center will provide a match of \$8,380, and a Merck Family Fund grant will pay \$4,720 of Smith's salary and FB.

Travel:

Smith will travel 3488 miles for this project. At .39/mile, the total mileage cost will be \$1,360; meals and lodging for 14 days/nights is estimated at \$1,100 for a total travel budget of \$2,460. Simon Nature Center requests \$1,280 from CEP for this component of the project. The Merck Family Fund will pay \$1,180 of the travel expenses.

Supplies:

Participating teachers will each receive \$30 of EE resources (420 teachers x \$30 = \$12,600). Simon Nature Center will also need \$300 for paper, copies and a website software program for a total Supplies Budget of \$12,900. Simon requests \$6,562 from CEP. Population Connection, based in Washington, D.C., has agreed to donate \$2,000 of resources (see letter of support, Attachment C); Merck will contribute \$4,338 to teacher resources.

Other:

In the Other category, Simon Nature Center anticipates \$3,120 will be used for contracted services. In addition, 100 teachers will pay \$10 registration fees for a total of \$1,000. (This \$1,000 will be used to pay for food and refreshments.) Another \$80 of in-kind support will be provided by Kyle Park Nature Center (they will waive rental fees for the training facilities) for a total budget of \$4,200 in the "Other" category. Simon Nature Center requests CEP provide \$3,120 for contracted services for TJ Matthews from Greenwood University, who will teach one of the courses (78 hrs @ \$40/hr.).
