RECYCLING USED OIL FILTERS

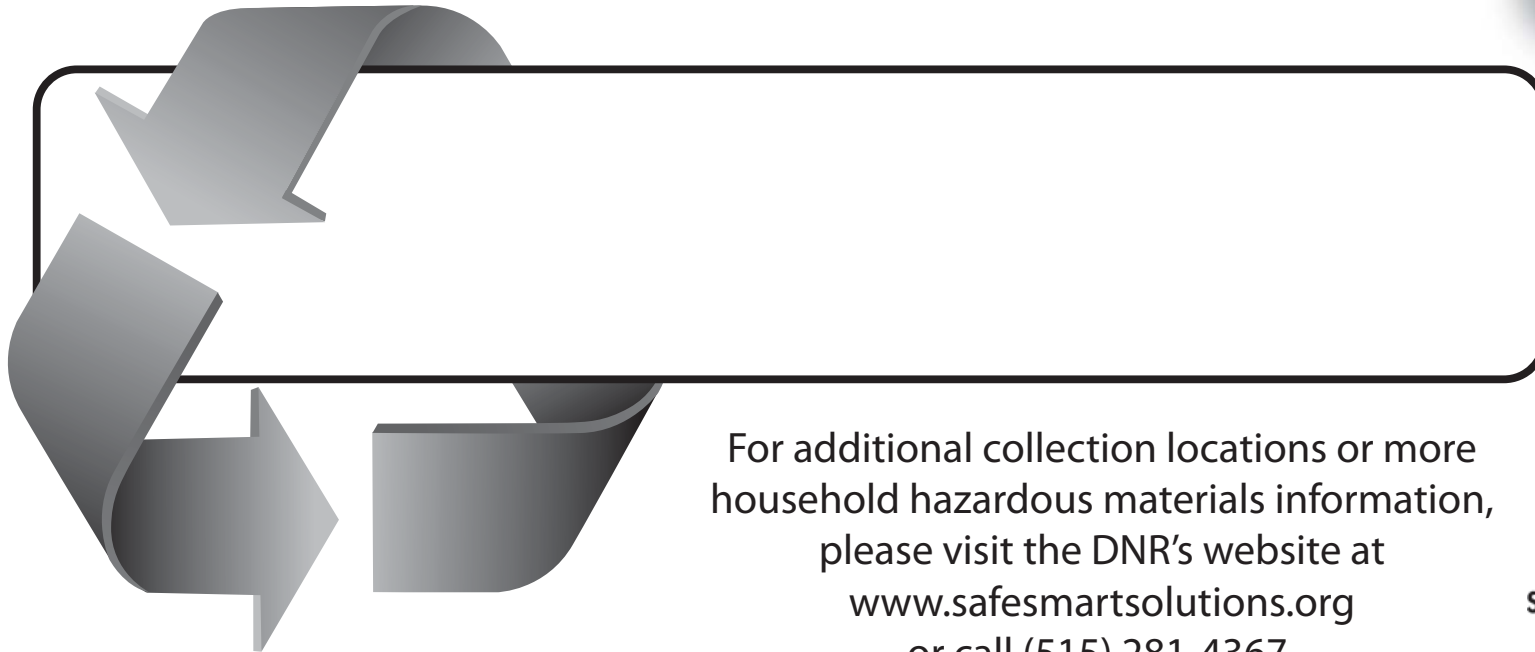
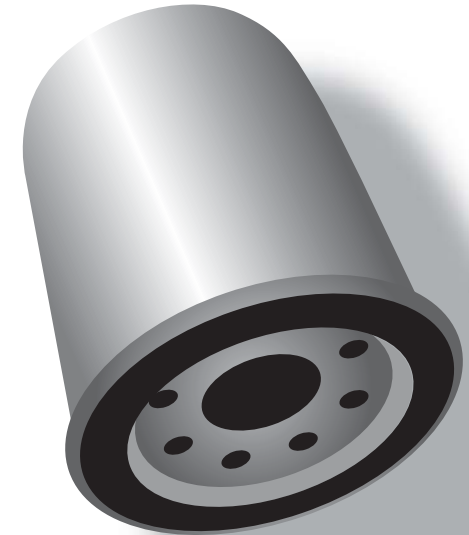
Conserves energy and reuses limited resources

State law encourages household recycling of used oil filters

State law requires businesses to separate used oil filters for recycling

State law requires retailers who sell oil filters to either

- a) accept used oil filters from customers **OR**
- b) post notice of the nearest location where a customer may recycle their used oil filters. The nearest location is listed below:
