Dear Mr. Vonk:

The DNR is imposing new regulations and deadlines for local landfills. The Adair County Board of Supervisors feels that an adequate time frame to meet the requirements has not been given.

Specific concerns:

- Additional engineering costs for redesigning the present site.
- Loss of approximately 30 years of airspace and revenue.
- Additional financing of a new site with subtitle D specifications.
- Additional or accelerated funding of closure/post closure accounts.
- Financial burden to possibly construct a transfer station
- Financial burden to locate another facility to take the solid waste if a transfer station is constructed

The two-year time limit does not allow the Adair County Sanitary Landfill Commission adequate time to study and evaluate options, let alone prepare financially. May we suggest a longer time line, preferably five years or more?
