Four Categories

- Residential / Consumer
 - Waste generated in single- and multiple-family homes; includes apartments, condos
- Commercial
 - Waste originating in wholesale, retail, service establishments, including office buildings, stores, markets, theaters, hotels, warehouses
- Industrial / Construction & Demolition (C&D)
 - Waste generated during manufacturing activities & processes. **DOES NOT** include office, cafeteria waste or other types that are not direct result of production processes
- Institutional / Hospital, Schools, Government Entities
 - Waste originating in schools, hospitals, prisons, research institutions, government & public buildings, nursing homes

1. Current & emerging issues
2. Existing programs (Current State)
 - Are there opportunities for enhancements & continuous improvement?
3. New programs and opportunities
 - If applicable: opportunity for product stewardship?

4. Recommendations (prioritize / narrow down considering the following:)
 - Environmental impact

 - Infrastructure
 - Development & implementations costs
 - Markets
 - Economic impact
 - Education and awareness
 - Funding recommendations
