



listed may have no antlerless licenses available in any season, paid or landowner-tenant.

2) Landowner-tenant free and reduced-fee Antlerless-only licenses will be available only in counties and seasons where paid licenses are available.

3) As in the past hunters may purchase two Any-deer licenses – one for Archery season and one for any firearm season (Early Muzzleloader season has a quota of 7,500 licenses). For the first time, hunters may hunt with Antlerless-only licenses in any season they are available regardless of the season selected for their Any-deer firearm license.

**Exception: Hunters may not obtain paid licenses for both the first and second shotgun seasons.**

4) The January Antlerless Season will be shortened 7 days in the southern two tiers of counties to match the rest of the state. Centerfire rifles may be used in the last 7 days of this season but only in the southern two tiers of counties. Semi-automatic centerfire rifles used during this 7-day period must contain no more than 6 rounds in the chamber and magazine combined.

5) Youth Deer Season. The minimum age and Hunter Education requirement have been removed for the Youth Deer Season.

6) Youth and Disabled Season Hunters: Youth and disabled hunters that purchase a license for this season may get paid licenses for other seasons like any other hunter.

7) Hunters must report each harvested deer to the DNR's new Harvest Reporting System ([see the proposal for reporting deer and turkeys](#)).

8) Landowners and tenants and their eligible family members must register through the ELSI system before obtaining free or reduced-fee deer hunting licenses ([see the proposal for landowner-tenant registration](#)).
