Dear Administrator Gulliford:

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is submitting the annual report required by the sulfur dioxide (SO₂) Data Requirements Rule (DRR, 80 FR 51051, August 21, 2015), pursuant to the provisions of 40 CFR 51.1205(b). The enclosed report, due July 1, addresses Louisa and Pottawattamie Counties. These counties were designated attainment/unclassifiable (83 FR 1098, January 9, 2018) for the 2010 1-hour SO₂ national ambient air quality standard (NAAQS) based, in part, on modeling of actual emissions.

The DNR documented the annual SO₂ emissions from the sources in Iowa that were modeled based on their actual emissions. The DNR concludes that additional modeling is not necessary to determine that both Louisa and Pottawattamie Counties continue to attain the 1-hour SO₂ NAAQS. No other areas in Iowa are currently subject to the DRR's ongoing reporting requirements.

Pursuant to 40 CFR 51.1205(b), the draft report was made available for public inspection as a stand-alone document. A 32-day public inspection period was held that began May 15, 2020, and ended June 15, 2020. Notice was provided using the DNR's Air Quality News listserv, which reaches over 17,000 subscribers. No public comments were received.
