
- Mass mailing regarding SPARS issues, notices and updates

 - Testing needed to determine security and usability.





Needs Assessment & Prioritize Changes to SPARS

- Pressing changes for TV, MSEIQ & CP
 - Upload or import facility data or emissions to the system.
 - Redesigning SPARS data entry screens to match paper forms (catch up with program).
 - Include use of additional browser platforms.
 - Only possible when Appeon Corporation makes a plugin available OR
 - Find a replacement system for SPARS Web

SPARS Tentative Modernization Plans

- SLEIS Analysis (First half of 2013)
 - Confirm if SLEIS is a viable upgrade option
 - High level requirements, time and cost estimates
- SLEIS Data Migration and Internal Implementation (2013-15)
 - Detailed requirements
 - Data migration
 - Implement SLEIS internally and use for EIS submission to EPA
 - Funding from Exchange Network grant
- SLEIS Full Implementation
 - Permit applications
 - Used internally and by industry
 - Requires additional funding
