The programs we cover:

Air Quality, Solid Waste, Water Supply, Waste Water, Flood Plains,  
Dams, Underground Storage Tanks, Animal Feeding Operations,  
and Emergency Response.

# The Field Services and Compliance Bureau

The staff:

90 people divided among the 6 field offices  
and central office support

In the Field Office Air Quality Program:  
6 FTE (Full Time Equivalent) dedicated to Title V Major  
3 FTE dedicated to Minor Air
