

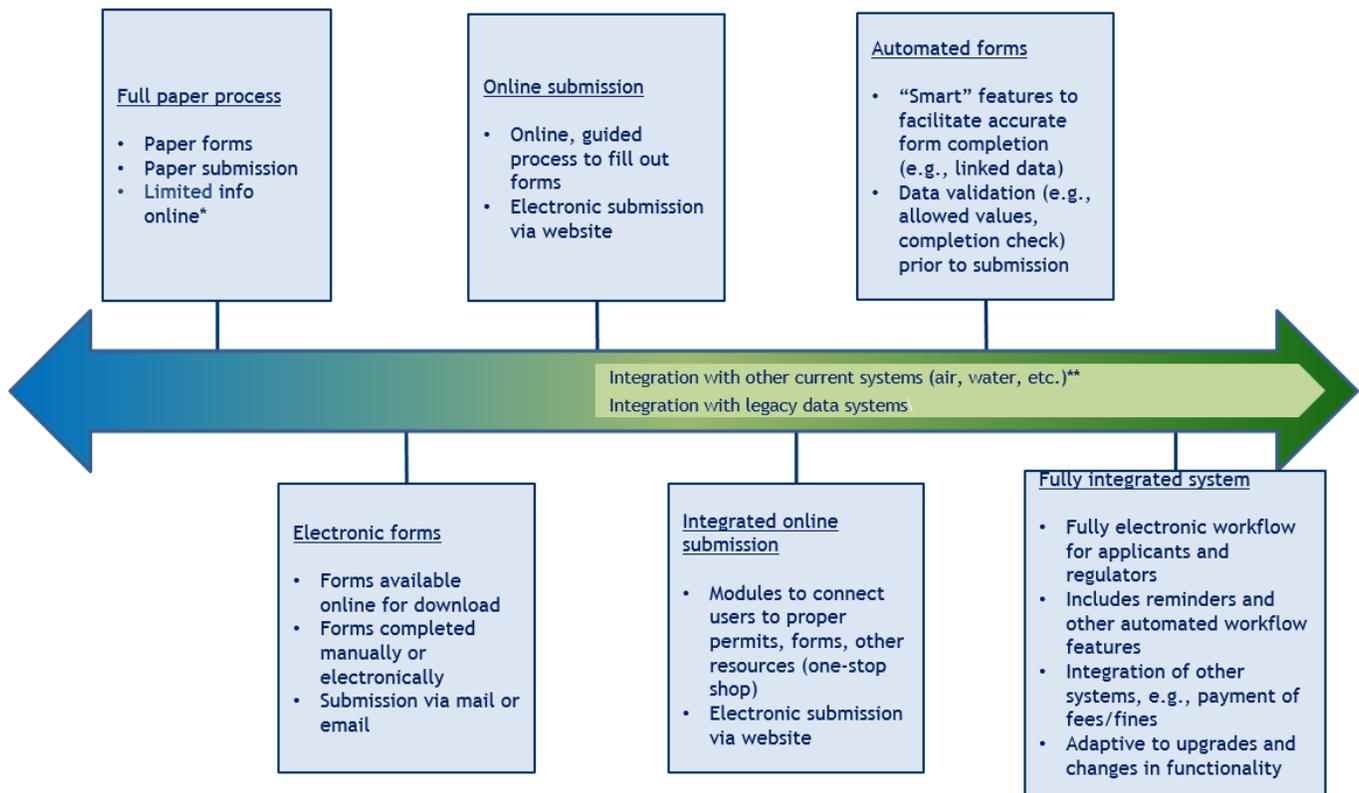
What is the eAirPermitting Project?

The DNR is in the early stages of developing business requirements for a replacement of the State Permitting & Air Reporting System (SPARS). SPARS was built in the late 1990's for outdated hardware specifications and using technology that is difficult to maintain. Most of the forms required as a component of the application are outdated.

It is an opportunity to build from the momentum of the State & Local Emissions Inventory System (SLEIS) project and develop a modern and efficient e-permitting application and tracking system. The DNR's eAirPermitting project has received national attention as a possible solution to the problem of legacy electronic permit application systems (multi-media).

The goal of this project is to accurately gather requirements to build a solution that simplifies the application process for customers providing an easy-to-use portal for submitting and tracking permit applications online.
