



## ***Improved Clinch Knot***

1. Pass the line through the eye of the hook or lure and wrap it around the standing line five or six times. Thread the line through the first loop above the eye and then through the big loop.
2. Hold the free end of the line and the standing line. Moisten the line and pull the coils tight against the eye of the hook. Clip the free end.



## ***Palomar Knot***

1. Run the line through the eye of the hook. Then run it back through to make a loop.
2. Bring the loop behind the standing line and up through the center of the hole.
3. Pass the hook through the loop.
4. Moisten the line. Pull it tight against the hook and trim the tag end.



## ***Blood Knot***

1. Overlap the ends of the two lines to be joined about six inches. Take the free end of one line and make five or six turns around the other line. Repeat for the other line.
2. Run the free ends of the lines through the loop between the two lines in directions opposite each other.
3. Pull each free end and begin to tighten the knot. Moisten the knot. Finish tightening it and clip the free ends.
