



FINAL BONDING CHECKLIST

Note: All of these items must be completed for the process to continue.

Application must be correctly completed

- Personal information filled in at the top section of the application – We must have one of the following ways to identify you
 - IDNR number
 - Iowa Driver's license Number
 - Social Security Number

- Boat **OR** ATV/Snowmobile/ORM/ORV section

Make certain that is hull ID or vehicle registration number correct and not transposed

- Bond portion on the back

Must contain a book value print out that was either determined by going to the <http://www.nadaguides.com> Or signed off by a DNR certified dealer.

Conservation Officer must inspect the vessel/vehicle and sign in the bond box.
Applicant must sign on the bottom of the back of the application.

Additional documentation needed:

- Photograph of the rear, side and front of the vehicle/vessel
- Photograph or pencil tracing of the hull ID/Serial number/VIN#
- Bill of sale/Proof of ownership

Statutory Surety Bond - (To be filled out by any insurance/bond company when they write and sell the bond). The value of the bond should be for 1½ times the current determined value of the vehicle/vessel. The cost is determined by the insurance/bond company.

Make certain that the bond has a bond number and that the Hull or Vehicle identification number is exactly as it appears on your vessel/vehicle and the numbers are not transposed.
