All specimens must be lawfully acquired, within season, and under proper license. All specimens must be tagged with the owner's name, address, and date of kill. A federal taxidermy license is also required if migratory birds are to be mounted. By signing below, I acknowledge and understand the rules and regulations regarding having this permit and realize that all transactions, tags, and specimens left in the custody of a taxidermist by another person shall be open to inspection by a conservation officer at any reasonable time.
