Before importation, an owner or operator of an aquaculture unit must provide the date of the most recent disease inspection on the imported lot of fish and a statement certifying the fish, eggs or semen of any species of the salmonid family (trout, salmon, and char) and ictalurid family (catfishes and bullheads) have been inspected for these diseases listed on Page 2. All disease certification statements must include the results of the latest inspection and be issued and signed by an approved certified pathologist or veterinarian.

- Persons or companies not holding a valid license must acquire that license before this application can be completed.

Species of the Salmonid family must be certified free of the following diseases:

- Viral Hemorrhagic Septicemia (VHS),
- Infectious Pancreatic Necrosis (IPN),
- Whirling Disease (Myxosoma Cerebralis),
- Infectious Hematopoietic Necrosis (IHN),
- Ceratomyxosis (Ceratomyxa shasta),
- Bacterial Kidney Disease (R. salmoninarium),
- Proliferative Kidney Disease (PKD),
- Enteric Redmouth (Yersinia ruckeri),
- Vibriosis (*Vibrio sp.*).

Species of the Salmonid family must be inspected for Furunculosis (Aeromonas salmonicida)

Species of the Ictalurid (Catfish) family must be inspected for:

- Enteric Septicemia of Catfish (ESC or Edwardsiella ictaluri).
- Channel Catfish Virus Disease (CCVD)

Those diseases are classified as reportable diseases and importation will be permitted on a case by case basis.
