Bedrock Software Manual and Bedrock Site Monitoring Reports

The Tier 2 Bedrock Software Version 1.20 Software User's Manual has been revised.

Please note the bedrock software has not been updated to reflect the 2012 changes to water line receptor types. As such, locations in the software where "plastic water line" or "PWL" are used should be understood to refer to all current water line receptor types including PVC or gasketed mains, PVC or gasketed service lines, or PE/PB/AC mains or service lines. Refer to Tier 1 Guidance for more information on current water line receptor types and applicable target levels.

The bedrock software also has not been updated to reflect all current designated use surface water body classifications. However, bedrock target levels for the major three surface water body designated use classifications (state owned lake, drinking water, and all other classifications) remain the same.

Please be advised when completing a bedrock site monitoring report the Bedrock Site Monitoring Report signature page, Checklist, Potential Receptor Summary, Receptor Status Change, and Site Reclassification pages (DNR Form 542-0769) should be used.
