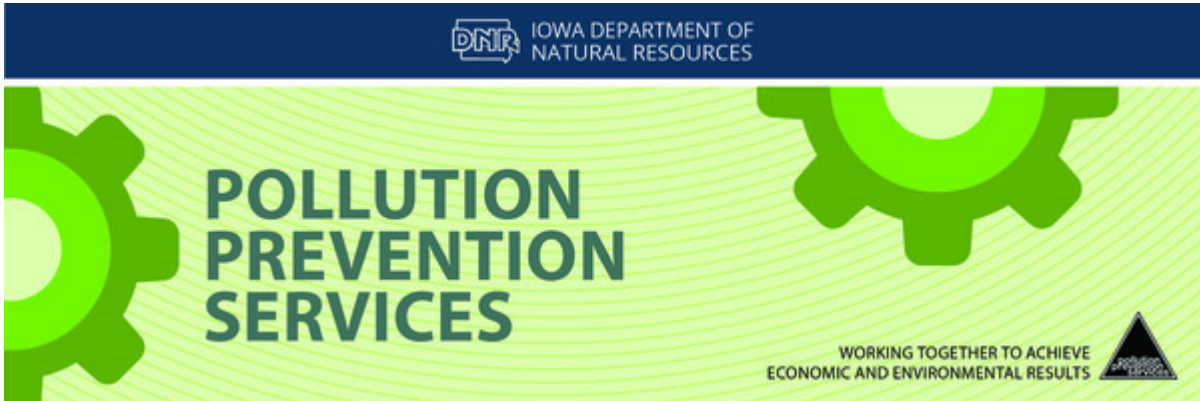

Get ready for the 2019 EPA Region 7 Pollution Prevention Awards!



The submission window for the [2019 EPA Region 7 Pollution Prevention \(P2\) Awards](#) is nearly here!

Starting January 7, companies in Region 7 are encouraged to consider submitting an application to EPA's awards program to highlight some of their successful onsite P2 projects and efforts. Have you achieved impressive energy reduction goals in the previous year? Pursued water reduction initiatives that are really driving your sustainability goals? Made strides towards eliminating use of hazardous materials onsite, or reduced your overall hazardous waste generation through P2 strategies? Consider submitting those or any other successful P2 efforts for an EPA award and be recognized!

Interested companies will complete and submit an online application on [EPA's award website](#). EPA will accept submissions between January 7 - February 18, 2019. Once the submission window closes, EPA will review all applications and select the winning companies.

All award winners will be notified by mid-March, with a recognition ceremony planned in April as part of the [2019 Midwest Environmental Compliance Conference](#) in Kansas City, MO. [Last year's 2018 winners](#) were highlighted and recognized by EPA Region 7 Administrator Jim Gulliford, along with EPA and state P2 staff.
