- Founded from the 1987 Groundwater Protection Act to provide environmental assistance to Iowa small businesses

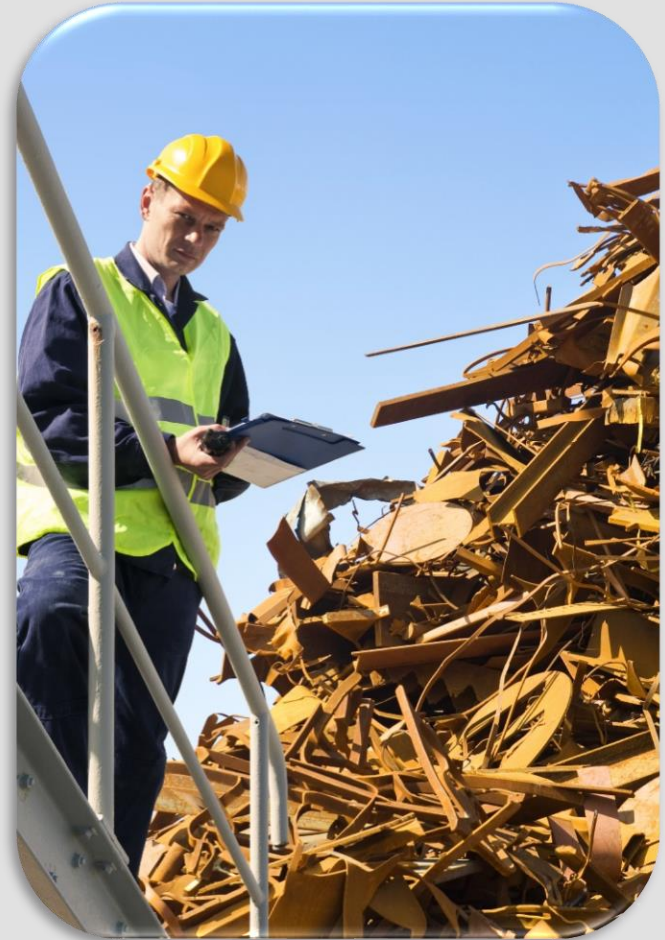

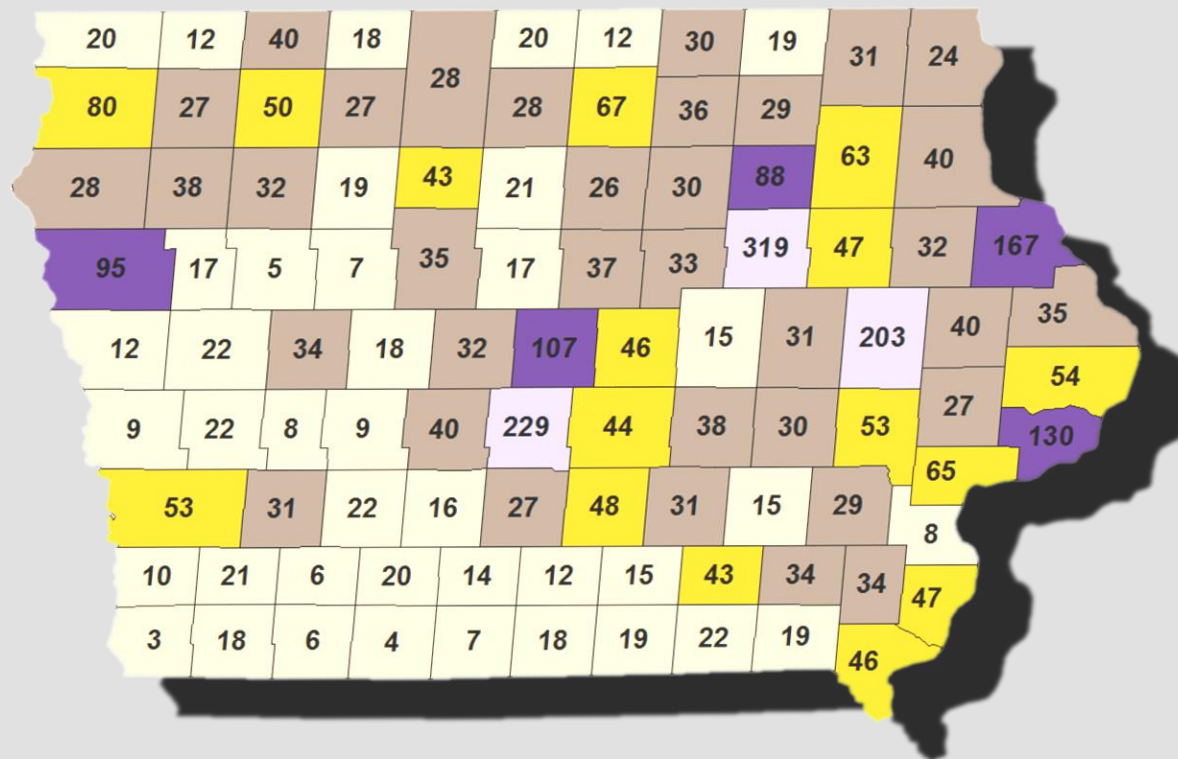
