



Waste Commission of Scott County (WCSC) Hazardous Materials Roundtable

For most Iowa businesses, managing waste streams is a part of daily operations that is challenging. Traditional non-hazardous wastes are one matter, but businesses must also maintain knowledge of and proper handling programs for other streams as well, including hazardous waste, universal waste, special waste, and more. Staying on top of the requirements may seem daunting, and businesses may not know what resources are available in the state to support these types of programs.

To address these challenges, the Waste Commission of Scott County (WCSC) is partnering with the Iowa DNR's Pollution Prevention Services program to deliver two separate interactive virtual roundtables addressing Universal Wastes and Special Wastes, two challenging waste classifications that bring with them different rules and considerations.

Each roundtable will provide an overview of the waste classification, including sessions from regulators discussing current requirements and best practices for managing the waste. Additional resources will be highlighted that can support Iowa businesses in meeting compliance obligations and reducing regulatory burdens by reducing the amount of waste being generated at the source. Additional time will be provided for Q&A with presenters and other attendees, to maximize information exchange. There will also be a dedicated session at the end of each roundtable for open-floor facilitated discussion and networking, to encourage exchange of ideas and strategies amongst peers.
