- Iowa law prohibits businesses from disposing of CRTs in a landfill
- Each CRT contains 5 to 7 pounds of lead
- \blacksquare Lead is harmful to the environment and your health

What can you do?

- Recycle unwanted CRTs through local programs
- Purchase plasma, LED or LCD televisions and computer monitors
