
INSTRUCTIONS TO UPDATE A DOCK PERMIT

Welcome to Iowa's online dock application process. The website to manage your dock permit can be found at www.iowadnr.gov/boatdocks. Click on **Sign In**. (See separate instructions if you need to create an A&A Account.)

- Fill in your account ID (remember to include @iowaid)
- Type in your password
- Click on Sign In


STEP 3 – CLAIMING A DOCK PERMIT (this step is only required once to place the permit into your personal account)

If you have already claimed the permit online and you see the permit in your grid, skip to **Step 6**.

If you are managing your dock permit online for the **first** time, you will answer "**Yes**" to the question about whether you have a dock permit.

If you have more than one dock permit, you will claim the other permits by going


through Claim Permit in the lefthand column.



STEP 4


- Enter your permit number.
- Click on **Search**.

If you do not know your permit number, contact the DNR for assistance. Please see the **Contact Us** tab on the lower left of the screen.




STEP 5

Click **Select** next to your permit number.



Once you have selected your permit, you will be asked to confirm that the permit is indeed your dock permit.

- Click **OK** (if the permit belongs to you)
- Next screen, click Claim Permit.



STEP 6 – DIRECTIONS TO UPDATE AN ACTIVE DOCK PERMIT

Once you have claimed your dock permit, it will show in your **My Account** page. To update an active dock permit, click on **Update**.

Your permit will then appear on your screen. Answer questions 1 through 10 correctly. Some information may be missing or incorrect, and you will need to fill it in. Once you have the top questions answered, scroll down and check the information for your dock(s) making any changes that you need.

If this permit is for a *commercial dock* (Class 4) or *government dock* (Class 2), your questions will be different than those displayed below.

NOTE: If your permit is determined to be Class 3 or Class 4, you are **required** to include a diagram of each dock before you can complete your application. Diagrams can either be created on your computer or you may draw them out and uploaded the picture to your computer via scanners, digital cameras or smart phones.

If you have more than one dock, you must provide the dimensions for each individual dock. Click on **add dock** to provide the information for additional docks.



STEP 7

- ✓ If no fees are due, skip to **Step 8**.
- ✓ If your update triggers a review or changes the permit from Class 1 to Class 3, you will see a Pending Admin Fee which must be paid before your change can be reviewed.
- ✓ If your update includes additional hoist fees, you will see Pending Hoist Fee which must be paid prior to installation of any hoist or docking a boat into the slip.

Once paid, fees are non-refundable. Online payments are easy! Simply click on Make Payment and you will be given the option to pay directly from your bank account, credit card or debit card.






NOTE: Convenience fees vary depending on the method of payment you choose.



Exit to the DNR system

Once your administrative fees have been paid, you can **Exit** out of the payment program and go back into the DNR boat dock program.



STEP 8

Permit updates may be instantly approved or, in certain cases, will be sent to the review process after an administrative fee has been paid.

If your permit is approved, you will be able to **print a confirmation letter** which will give you the information you need to sign your dock with the permit number and 911 address.

Dear Sandy Beaches:

Your Class 3 dock permit has been activated for the dock located at 1234 Whitesands Ln. Your dock permit number is 28.9533.3 and it expires <u>December 15, 2019</u>. Dock permits are only valid as long as they continue to meet the criteria they were permitted under. 571-16.7 authorizes issuance of a Class 3 dock permit for nonstandard private docks. A Class 3 permittee shall pay an annual administrative fee of 550 for each hoist or slip in excess of four. Any additional hoists/slip fees shall be due on March 1 or whenever a permit is modified by adding a hoist or slip. Any fees owed to the department shall be paid in full prior to the installation of any portion of a dock, hoist or slip. Application and hoist/slip fees are non-refundable.

All docks must have a sign with their local 911 street address, city and permit number, with all letters and numbers a minimum of 1" high, at the end of their dock. The name is not required.

Retain this letter for future reference. If you make any changes to your dock configuration, add or subtract hoists, change your permanent address, phone number or email, contact us at the address above.

Please contact us if you have any questions about your dock permit. When it is time to renew or change your permit, you may go online to www.iowadnr.gov for applications and further assistance.

Remember, the dock permitting process is not complete until your dock(s) is signed with your permit number and the dock's 911 address including city. Your name is not required. Check your dock permit number carefully after each update to a permit to make certain your sign reflect the correct permit number.


