## **DOCK CLASSIFICATION MATRIX**


The matrix below covers the different types of docks. This matrix is not exhaustive, it is meant as a quick tool for helping you determine which classification would apply to your dock. A more comprehensive way to determine which dock classification is right for you is to read the overview for each dock. Below are the four classes of docks.

- Class 1 Standard Private Dock
- Class 2 City or County Authorized Dock
- Class 3 Non-Standard Private Dock
- Class 4 Commercial Dock
