

Iowa DNR/Household Hazardous Materials

Material: Garden Fungicides

Potential Hazards: May contain captan, triforine, propylene glycol, chlorothalonil. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin; may cause redness or swelling of eyes, nose, throat or skin. Ingestion may cause nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.

Recycle/Reuse: If you have leftover products in usable condition, check with neighbors, church groups or the local community to see if they can use them. You may also take them to your local Regional Collection Center's swap shop for other residents to use.

Proper Disposal: Use this product up or bring it to your local Regional Collection Center, find yours at iowadnr.gov/hhm under the RCC tab.

Green Alternatives: Plant disease-resistant species or use fungicides based on potassium bicarbonate (baking soda), which is less hazardous for your family and the environment.
