Material: Project Glue

Potential Hazards: Glue may contain toluene, styrene, and/or acetone. Vapors are harmful. The product may be flammable and irritating to eyes and skin. If inhaled, glue may cause irritation to the nose, throat and respiratory tract. Ingestion may cause severe gastrointestinal distress; seek medical attention immediately.

Recycle/Reuse: If you have leftover products in usable condition, check with neighbors, church groups or the local community to see if they can use them. You may also take them to your local Regional Collection Center's swap shop for other residents to use.

Proper Disposal: Use this product up or take it to your local Regional Collection Center, find yours at <u>iowadnr.gov/hhm</u> under the RCC tab.

Green Alternatives: Use school glue sticks or white glue. Use physical attachments such as tape or staples.
