BASIC REQUIREMENTS:

(See also informational sheet: although no specific education or experience is required for other Natural Resource Aide positions in areas of Iowa DNR other than the Law Enforcement Bureau, these have additional requirements commensurate with the high responsibilities and demands of these specific positions in this Bureau.)

- Application Deadline (Must be postmarked): February 12, 2018.
- This application form will be submitted via the US Postal Service as directed at the end of this form.
- Dates of Employment: Mid-May through approximately Labor Day.
- 40 Hours/Week.
- Must be a United States citizen or be legally authorized to work in the United States.
- **MUST** be available for interviews **in early March** in Iowa. (Applicants will be notified of specifics if selected for interview.)
- **MUST** be available for **ALL** training (held on weekdays, typically beginning in Mid-May)
- Possess a valid motor vehicle operator's license.
- Submission to and clearance of a thorough background check. By submitting an application you are consenting to this check.
- Certification through Iowa's Boating Safety Education Program (AFTER hiring. Must be obtained before reporting for first workday and proof must be provided. You do NOT need to be certified in order to apply.)
- Current CPR Certification issued through the American Red Cross of the American Heart Association. (AFTER hiring. Must be obtained before reporting for first workday and proof must be provided. You do NOT need to be certified in order to apply.)
- Minimum Age: 18.

ADDUCANT NAME

- Graduated from or currently enrolled/on break between semesters of college, or about to enter first semester of college after high school graduation.
- Ability to work alone, with the public, in a law enforcement capacity, in <u>all conditions</u>, on <u>weekends</u>, and including <u>holidays</u>, <u>nights</u>, <u>and evenings</u>.
