


# **Notice of Relocation of Portable Equipment**

Owners and operators of portable equipment that are transferring portable equipment to **Buffalo**, **Cedar Rapids**, **Clinton**, **Council Bluffs**, **Mason City**, **or Muscatine must notify the department at least 14 days prior to transferring the equipment**. Owners and operators must notify the department at least 7 days prior to transferring equipment to all other areas in lowa. *See 567 IAC 22.3(3)"f" for complete rule*. If relocating to Linn County or Polk County please contact the local program office prior to relocating for Permit and Notification requirements.
