



Notice of Relocation of Portable Equipment

Owners and operators of portable equipment that are transferring portable equipment to **Buffalo, Cedar Rapids, Clinton, Council Bluffs, Mason City, or Muscatine must notify the department at least 14 days prior to transferring the equipment.** Owners and operators must notify the department at least 7 days prior to transferring equipment to all other areas in Iowa. *See 567 IAC 22.3(3)"f" for complete rule.* If relocating to Linn County or Polk County please contact the local program office prior to relocating for Permit and Notification requirements. 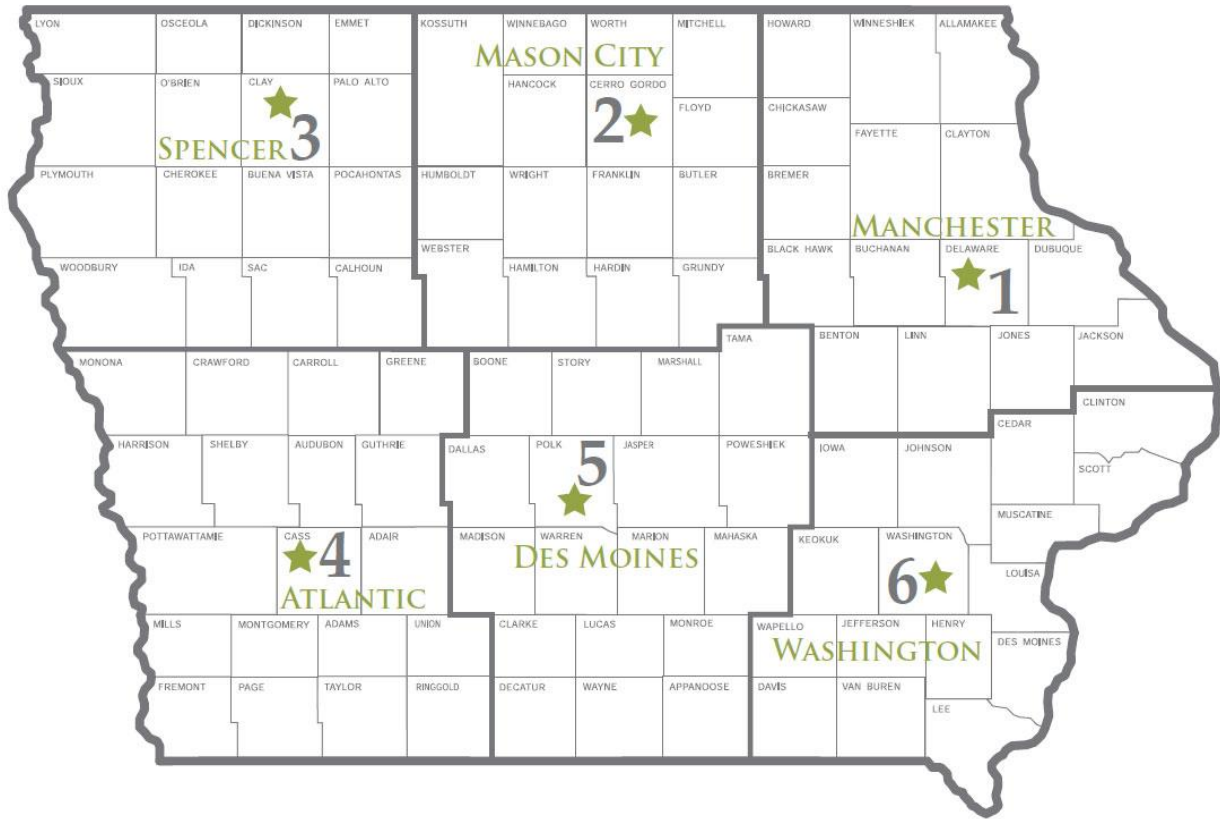
