The Department of Natural Resources will issue the licenses and tags listed below to a resident of Iowa who served in the armed forces of the United States on active federal service (other than training), who was disabled during that veteran's military service. To qualify due to disability, the law requires that the veteran be entitled to a service connected disability rating under the United States Code, Title 38, Chapter 11 and who also is a current resident of Iowa and have met our qualifications of residency, including being a resident of Iowa for at least 90 days prior to applying for this license.
