<u>Class 3</u> – Application fee shall be \$125 – due at time of application – for one or more individual private docks (Maximum 5 year term). Mooring buoys, swim rafts, swim platforms, trampolines or other structure(s) require a Class 3 permit. Checks or money orders only, payable to <u>Iowa Department of Natural Resources.</u>

Permittee shall pay an annual administrative fee of \$50 for each hoist/lift/slip/rack in excess of a total of 4 hoists/lifts/ slips/racks.

The hoist/lift/slip/rack fee shall be due on March 1 of each year or whenever a permit is modified by adding a hoist/lift/ slip/rack. Any fees owed to the department shall be paid in full prior to the installation of any portion of an individual private dock.

Application and hoist/lift/slip/rack fees are non-refundable.




