Department of Natural Resources.

A Class 4 permittee shall pay an annual administrative fee of \$50 for each hoist/lift/slip/rack <u>in excess</u> of a total of 6 hoists/lifts/slips/racks.

The hoist/lift/slip/rack fee shall be due on March 1 of each year or whenever a permit is modified by adding a hoist/lift/slip/rack. Any fees owed to the department shall be paid in full prior to the installation of any portion of a commercial dock.

Application and hoist/lift/slip/rack fees are non-refundable.




