


COACHES ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, coaches should report to the Coaches' Room located just in conference room A of the Varied Industries Building. Enter via admission office on the Southeast side. **Coaches will need to drop off entry fees at check-in in order to receive their team packets, which will include coach wristbands, scorecards, cups, and stickers.** Any last-minute authorized changes can be made to their roster and flights at this time. Only tournament officials will be allowed in the scorerooms. All issues should be reported to either the range master or to staff working in the Coaches' Room.

ARCHERS AND PARENTS ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, archers should wait in the designated area set forth by their respective coaches. **Note: All archers are required to arrive 45 minutes before their flight and report immediately to the designated inspection area. Archers must have their bows inspected before competing in both the bullseye and 3D tournaments.** Once parents and other family members or guests purchase their admission tickets, they may proceed into the main arena to locate a seat. **Note: Admission tickets will be sold only at the Varied Industries Building or online.**



WAITLIST


A waitlist will be offered during the tournament for individuals who have achieved the minimum qualifying score but have yet to secure a spot during registration. Waitlist spots will be filled based on the order in which they are received. If an archer is absent when their name is called, they will forfeit their place to the following individual on the list. The waitlist will restart each day. Doors open at 02:45 PM on Friday and 7:30 AM on Saturday and 6:30 AM on Sunday. **Note: To secure a spot on the waitlist, the archer and a BAI must be present and report to the Coaches' Room in the Varied Industries Building.**

TEAM CAMP AREAS

Please be respectful of the team camp areas in both buildings. Tables will be available for teams to set up as needed. Make sure to maximize the use of your space. Utilize bow racks, stack bow cases, and make use of the space on and below the tables to ensure that everyone has adequate room for their items. If you have finished shooting for the day and no longer need your equipment, please remove it from the building so that other teams can use the space. Sportsmanship off the range is just as important as it is on the range. Please be respectful and courteous to others and their equipment.

Team Camp Locations:

- Jacobson Exhibition Center (3D) - Warm-Up Arena is immediately east of the main arena.
- Varied Industries Building (Bullseye) - Conference rooms located in the hallway on the south side of the building. Please do not set up team camp areas near the concession stand or in the main arena where archers are shooting.



AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS

The awards ceremony will take place on Sunday, March 29th, at the Varied Industries Building. The ceremony will begin following the final bullseye tournament flight and any shoot offs (approximately 03:30 PM).

PRACTICE RANGE

The practice range is located in the southeast corner of the Varied Industries Building.

The range will open at 3:00 PM on Friday, 8:00 AM on Saturday, and 7:00AM Sunday.

The range will close when the last flight of the day begins.

The cost is \$5.00 (cash only) for 20 arrows per registered archer. Archers must supply their arrows.

Each paid registered archer can shoot two ends at 10 meters and two at 15 meters.

Voice commands will apply to the practice ranges. Whistle commands will be for the main Bullseye Range.

Only paid archers will be allowed beyond the waiting line.

If an archer fails to follow the rules and commands given by the volunteer range master, they could be disqualified from the state tournament.

Remember that the practice range is run and operated by volunteers. It can be shut down at any time if problems arise.



EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY

Only official event photographers and pre-approved media outlets will be allowed to capture images in front of the coaches' line, from the coaches and score rooms, or the balconies. All spectators must remain behind the coach's line except during the awards ceremony. At the awards ceremony, there will be a designated space between targets 25-30 for photos. Coaches and parents can take individual and team award photos, **after** the official tournament photos are taken.

General Photography Etiquette

- Avoid using flash for when archers are on the line shooting – you'll want to minimize any disturbances during their flights.
- It's okay to use flash during social breaks or in the team camp area when needed, but natural light looks fantastic!
- Be aware of shutter sounds. Single-frame shooting is recommended; motor drive is not.
- Be aware of the physical audience and how your movements affect the attendee experience. A good photographer seems invisible to attendees!



Important Notes:

- If your team qualifies, you **MUST** register and compete as a full qualified team. This means at least 12 archers with at least 4 of each gender for bullseye and 6 archers with at least 2 of each gender for 3D.
- If you cannot “field” a full qualified team, only your archers that qualify to register as individuals are eligible to participate (*those that finish in the top 10 individually in their division*).
- Teams and individuals are not guaranteed shooting spots. Teams/Individuals will be assigned shooting positions based on their tier, score/rank, preferences.
- Qualified teams and individuals from all states may register for either one but not both national tournaments.
