The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is proposing issue a Title V Operating Permit for South Central Iowa Solid Waste Authority (SCISWA). This facility is located at 1736 Hwy T17, Tracy, IA 50256. DNR is currently reviewing an application for renewal submitted by South Central Iowa Solid Waste Authority (SCISWA) to operate their existing landfill.

South Central Iowa Solid Waste Authority (SCISWA) is an area source subject to the National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) 40 CFR 63 Subpart AAAA <u>and</u> a minor source subject to New Source Performance Standard (NSPS) 40 CFR 60 Subpart XXX which requires the facility to apply for a Title V permit for the affected units. Therefore, the facility is required to apply for a Title V permit and, under 567 Iowa Administrative Code 24.101(1)"c", only the NESHAP <u>or</u> NSPS affected units at the facility must be covered by the Title V permit. This facility has the potential to emit the following air pollutants annually:

PM-2.5 (particulate matter 2.5 microns or less in diameter): 0 tons PM-10 (particulate matter ten microns or less in diameter): 0 tons

Particulate Matter: 0.31 tons Sulfur Dioxide: 0.92 tons Nitrogen Oxides: 0.74 tons

Volatile Organic Compounds: 2.59 tons

Carbon Monoxide: 15.33 tons

Lead: 0 tons

Hazardous Air Pollutants: 3.72 tons

Based on the information provided in the Title V Operating Permit application, the DNR has made an initial determination that the facility meets all the applicable criteria for the issuance of an operating permit specified in 567 IAC 24.107.

The public comment period for the draft permit will run from May 1, 2025 through May 31, 2025. During the public comment period, anyone may submit written comments on the permit. Mail signed comments to Zane Peters at the DNR address shown above. The beginning date of this public comment period also serves as the beginning of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) 45-day review period, provided the EPA does not seek a separate review period.

Written requests for a public hearing concerning the permit may also be submitted during the comment period. Any hearing request must state the person's interest in the subject matter, and the nature of the issues proposed to be raised at the hearing. DNR will hold a public hearing upon finding, on the basis of requests, a significant degree of relevant public interest in a draft permit. DNR will keep a record of the issues raised during the public participation process, and will prepare written responses to all comments received. The comments and responses will be compiled into a responsiveness summary document. After the close of the public comment period, DNR will make a final decision on the renewal application. The responsiveness summary and the final permit will be available to the public upon request.
